Think of your AI designs as a professional artist's impression, not a technical blueprint. They are brilliant for capturing a specific mood, style, and colour palette. Sometimes, the AI will invent a piece of furniture that doesn't exist or imagine lighting that isn't physically possible.

Don't worry! This is normal. The goal isn't to find the exact chair from the image, but to find a chair with a similar style and feel. This kit is designed to help you translate that artistic inspiration into a beautiful, real-world space.



Feeling prepared when you speak to builders, decorators, or electricians makes all the difference.


Use this checklist to ensure you get all the information you need to make a confident decision.

- Is this timeline dependent on any other work being completed first?
- How do you prefer to handle communication and project updates? (e.g., email, phone calls)

- Can you provide proof of your insurance?
- Can I see a few examples of similar projects you have completed?
- What is your payment schedule? (e.g., deposit, milestone payments)
- How do you handle unforeseen issues or changes to the project scope?
